Report of TC 100/AGS after the meeting held 2009-05-20 at Consumer Electronics Association (CEA) in Arlington/Virginia, USA.

BACKGROUND

TC 100/AGS held a meeting 2009-05-20; its next meeting is planned for 2009-10-18 in Tel Aviv, Israel in conjunction with the 73rd IEC General Meeting.

B.1 Follow-up of Response Plan on the PACT report

Technical report(s) on TC100 object identification and classification:

- Report of the stage 0 project --- (H. Ikeda) 100/AGS(Secr.)344

The chairman introduced the input document AGS(Secr.)344 on behalf of Prof. Ikeda reporting the recent progress until now on TC 100 object ID. AGS requested Dr. H. Ikeda to carry on the project.

B.2 Follow-up of other issues of the 23rd meeting

- (1) Digital TV receiver and mobile equipment
- DVB-H mobile TV market status --- (P. Talmola) 100/AGS(Secr.)362

Dr. Talmola reported recent marketing status on DVB-H mobile TV.

- Common API for T-DMB receivers --- (J. Y. Lee) 100/AGS(Secr.)357 Prof. Lee revised his previous report [328] as [357] and introduced it and AGS understood the common API as requirements from the customers/viewers. Because this issue has been already allocated to TA 1, AGS decided to forward [357] to TA 1 and requested Korean NC starting a discussion there about an NP on this topic.

(2) Digital Cinema

- Reports of SMPTE DC28 and ISO/TC 36 --- (M. Hyman) 100/AGS(Secr.)356 Document [356] reported mainly SMPTE DC28 activities. Because Mr. Mark Hyman has already left SMPTE, either he or someone appointed by him continues this task in the future.

(3) TC100 security

- Report of Adhoc Group on IETF scheme for TC100 security standardization --- (J. Yoshio and R. Atarashi)100/AGS(Secr.)345

In order to revise "TC 100 guidelines and procedures" at the earliest timing, AGS requested Mr. Yoshio to bring the revised [345] reflecting the discussion at the meeting to AGM tomorrow.

Ms. Baronas, who is chairing TC 100 energy efficiency Ad-Hoc group, reported its activities based on a series of documents. AGS requested the group bringing [355] to AGM for proposing a new TA on energy efficiency.

- Battery charging interface for small hand-held multimedia devices --- (P. Talmola) 100/AGS(Secr.)350, 100/AGS(Secr.)363
- Low Voltage Direct Current (LVDC) distribution systems --- (N. Minami) 100/AGS(Secr.)351

- Smart Grids --- (N. Minami) 100/AGS(Secr.)352
- Korea's energy-efficiency policies and activities related to management of energy at home --- (J. Y. Lee) 100/AGS(Secr.)358

AGS considered these input documents on 'battery charge interface,' 'LVDC,' 'Smart Grids' and Korean energy-efficiency policies. Based on the discussion, AGS recommended TC 100 to take into account these topics when it considers energy efficiency issues.

Note from TC 100 Secretary: Battery charge interface issues were considered at TC 100/AGM meeting on the next day of AGS meeting.

B.3 New proposals

AGS received a series of reports regarding High-level meeting between ITU-T, JTC 1 and TC 100, and its Adhoc meeting from Dr. Hirakawa. AGS appreciated these activities and requested him further coordination efforts between ETSI in addition to ITU-T and JTC 1.

- Status reports for the common text on TA8 permission codes --- (S. Matsumura and S. Hirakawa) 100/AGS(Secr.)348

AGS recognized the current standardization status of TA 8 permission codes and twin-text standardizing solution with ITU-T SG 16/WP 2/16.

- (2) New TC 100 standardization model including IPTV, PC hardware and etc.
- Requirements and the 1st working draft for the standardization model --- (J. Yoshio) 100/AGS(Secr.)359

AGS recognized importance of the TC 100 reference model including IPTV receivers and its intra home connection as well as PC hardware, etc, proposed by Mr. Yoshio. AGS requested him to prepare an NP on this topic.

- (3) Relationship between TC 100 and TC 108
- Relationship between TC 100 and TC 108, and proposal to modify the scopes --- (S. Hirakawa) 100/AGS(Secr.)353

Mr. Hirakawa reported the result of the meeting between TC 100 and TC 108 regarding the performance and safety standards of brown goods in order to follow the relation between TC 59 for performance and TC 61 for safely of white goods. AGS requests AGM to review the proposed modification of TC 100 scope.

AGS received the report from the accessibility project from Ms. Baronas and requests Ms. Baronas to report of updated information of TC100 accessibility

AGS received an extensive CEA report of its 3D Adhoc from Mr. Markwalter. AGS thanks CEA and requests it to continue further activities on this subject.
