1. Opening and reconfirmation of AGS scope --- 100/AGS<u>233rev</u>

Chairman opened the meeting at 8:59 of 2016-10-05.

Mr. Valenta provided host remark and expected strategic discussion for TC100.

AGS thanked Austria NC/OVE and Mr. Valenta for hosting AGS meeting and providing nice meeting facilities and refreshments.

Chairman requested the roll call of attendees.

Chairman explains the scope of AGS by using document 100/AGS233er.
